When the interveiws started he seemed to infer in many instances that I was mentally unbalanced because I did not want to die for my country, when I questioned his line of r reasons being as I did not see how he arrived at dieing in relation to killing another human being he skirted the issue and refused to give any real answer. There wre sseveral instances where the chaplain would also state that I appeared not to be listening to what he w as sating and I would answer that I did not see that I came to listen to him lecture me on his st of merals but rather to explain my own. At an answer like that he would become angry and tell me that i *********** was being "smart"

He skirted the issue of the churches attitude toward war and concentrated on the nvies importance in the safety of the world today. When I would aske what that had to do whith killing in war he again would not answer the question but would tack off on another subject, some times sayings things like"I must pray more, are a very mixed up person and I hope you find out before you cause damage to your future this he aften accented by personnel stories of his youth and the socialist actions of those his age who found out to late that the scialist movement was really a communist subversion and who then had to pay for they were quite obviously wrong in veiw of the world sit uatiom

The chaplain also appeared to place a great deal of store in the fact that i had typing errors in my application even though I explaind to him that I had not typed the paper but a freind had. His veiw was that I was incapable of tinking the thoughts in the paper because I couldn't speal even at the level
